Literally, this dish is called "**Pine Nut Fish**" but I prefer calling it the famous "Inside Out Fish." A fish is turned inside out, fried, and topped with a sweet sauce and pine nuts. This makes it much easier to avoid bones than would be with a typical Chinese fish dish.

(Sichuan) "**Boiled Water Fish**" In this dish, a live fish is killed, chopped up and boiled in a big pot of oil along with vegetables including, but not limited to, bok choy, lettuce, or sprouts. (very spicy)
