拉面	la1 mian4	"pulled" noodles; long and stringy
刀削面	dao1 xiao1 mian4	"knife cut" noodles
面片	mian4 pian4	little pieces of noodles
线面	xian4 mian4	string noodles
果条	guo3 tiao2	fried crullers
包子	bao1 zi3	steamed buns with meat or vegetables inside
小笼包	xiao3 long2 bao1	miniature steamed buns with meat or vegetables inside
馒头	man4 tou2	steamed bread without anything inside
面包	mian4 bao1	bread (Western, not Chinese bread)
馄饨	hun2 tun2	wontons
水饺, 饺子	shui3 jiao3, jiao3 zi3	dumplings
猪肉水饺	zhu1 rou4 shui3 jiao3	pork dumplings
牛肉水饺	niu2 rou4 shui3 jiao3	beef dumplings
白菜猪肉水饺	bai2 cai4 zhu1 rou4 shui3 jiao3	napa and pork dumplings
香菇猪肉水饺	xiang1 gu3 zhu1 rou4 shui3 jiao3	mushroom and pork dumplings
韭菜水饺	jiu3 cai4 shui3 jiao3	leek dumplings
四季豆猪肉水饺	si4 ji4 dou4 zhu1 rou4 shui3 jiao3	string bean and pork dumplings
